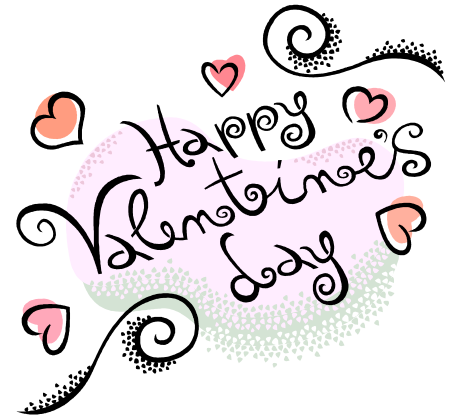

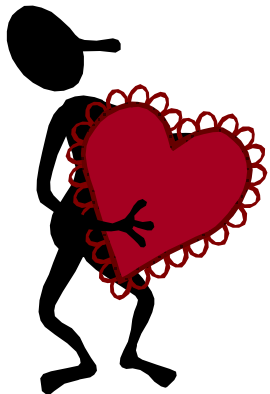
LISA LING: "OPENING MINDS AND HEARTS TO THE ISSUES SURROUNDING US"
