Add Procedure

Through Thursday of the first week of the semester, students may add courses provided that seats are still available. Adding courses which are full requires a signed **Add Card** from the instructor teaching the course. All **Add Cards** must be dropped off at the Student Service Center, C.B. Hedgcock, Room 2201, 906-227-1221, for processing.

Drop Procedure

Students may drop courses in accordance with the schedule below. Students desiring to drop a course should contact the Student Service Center, C.B. Hedgcock, Room 2201, 906-227-1221, for processing. No instructor signatures are required. The following table shows the academic deadlines for adding courses, dropping courses and refunds. The deadlines occur at 5 p.m. on the days shown in the following tables:

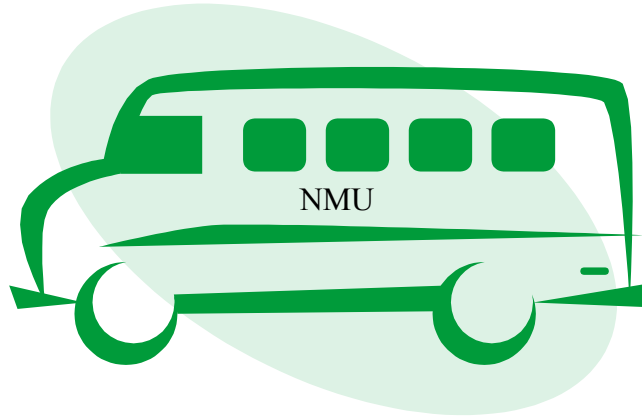
Boxing:

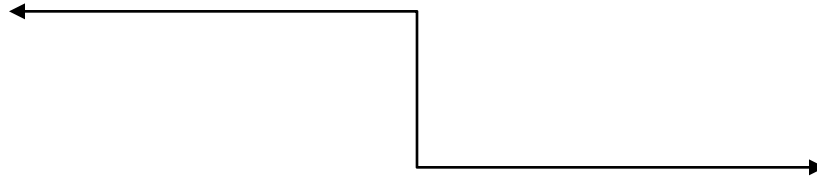
